The frog thought of a plan. One day, he tied a string to the mouse's tail and the other end to his leg. Then he jumped into the pond.

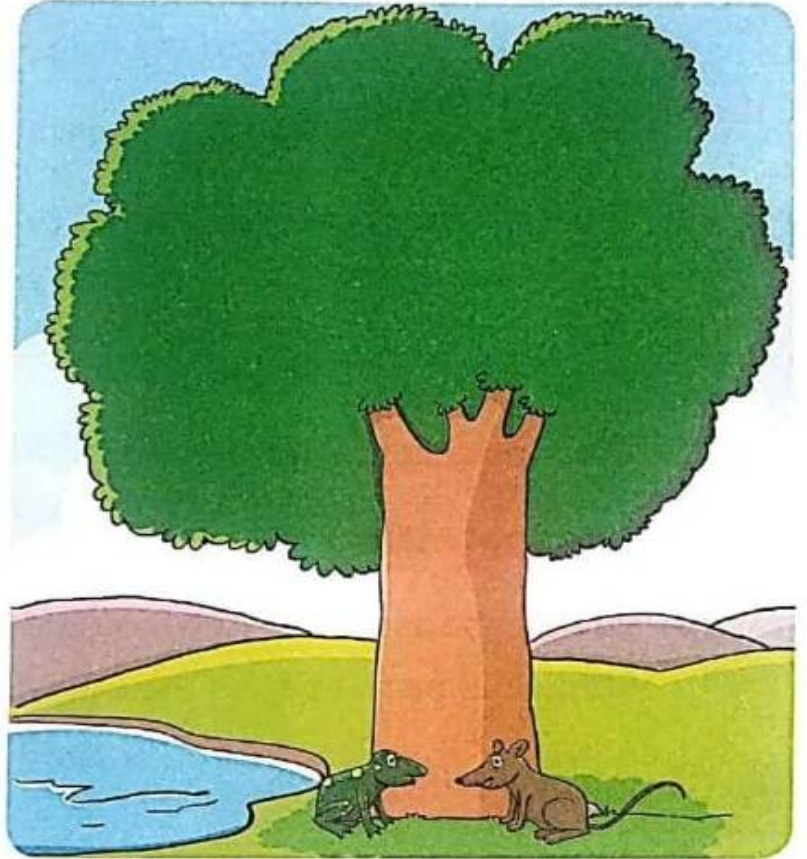
